

LUTTONS PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF ORDINARY MEETING

Held at Kirby Grindalythe Village Hall on Thursday 22 August 2024 at 7pm

There were 8 members of the public present, including 3 planning applicants.

1) Non-attendance of Councillors

Apologies were received from Cllr Ogden, Cllr Hughes and Cllr Wane, the reasons for absence were noted, and their apologies accepted.

2) No declarations of interest were given.

3) Public Participation Session

The Animals in Reach Planning Applicants, members of the Public attending and Councillors had a lengthy and in places detailed discussion about the planning application.

A number of issues were raised and discussed, including the parking overflow, accessibility, noise, use of buildings, maintaining current buildings and materials to be used across the development. Some things discussed were outside the remit of the planning process, but the majority were relevant.
